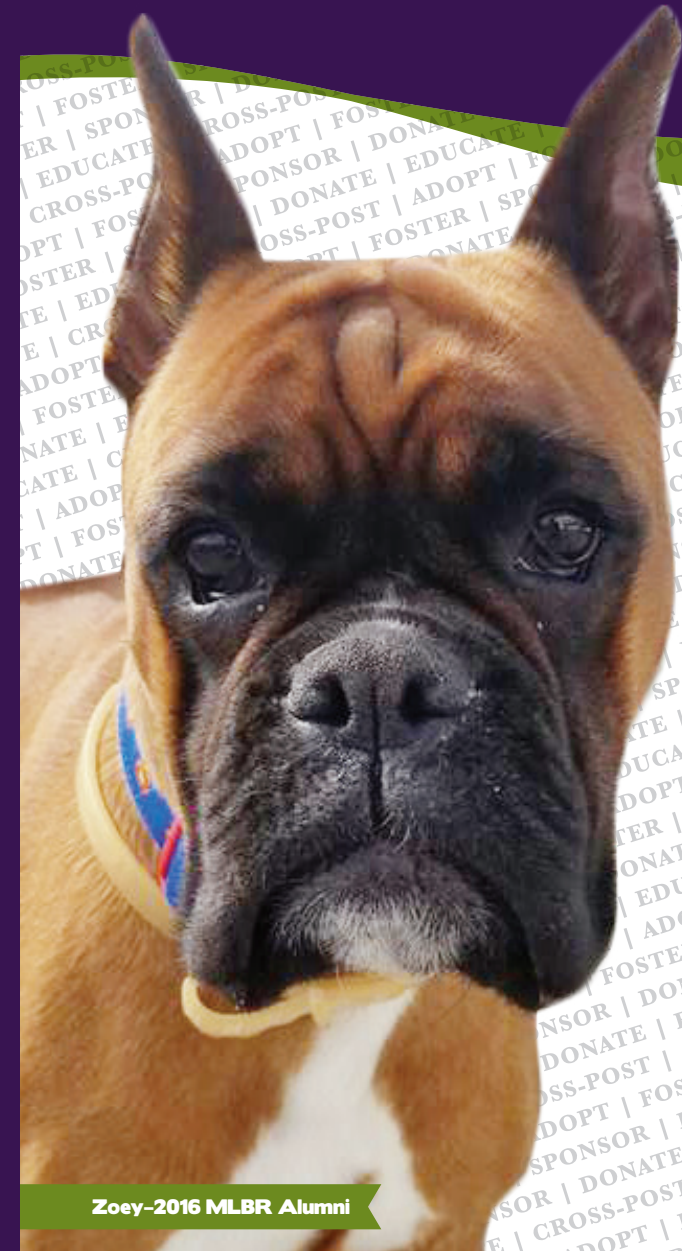

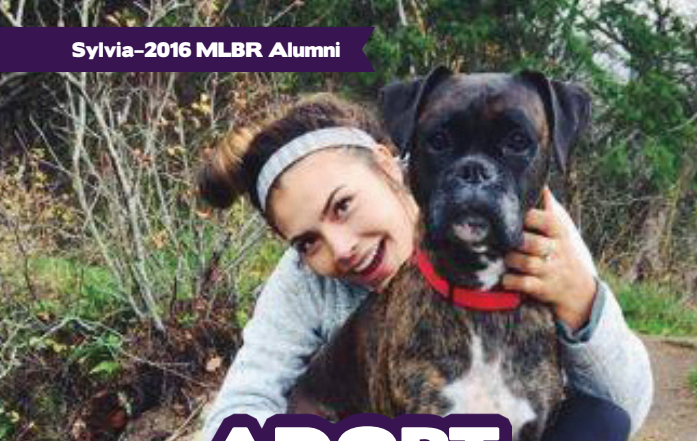

Application Process

Once an adoption application has been submitted via www.mustluvboxersrescue.com, a member of our adoption team will **screen applicants by conducting a phone interview, home check and verify references** and current veterinarian.

Adoption Process

Once an application is approved **MLBR will discuss available dogs and set up a meet when a match is made.** It is important that all members of the family attend, especially dogs, in the applicant's household.

If everything goes well we will finalize the paperwork and you can bring home your newest pack member. MLBR is a family and will always be available if our adopters have questions.

Fostering is a one-of-a-kind experience!

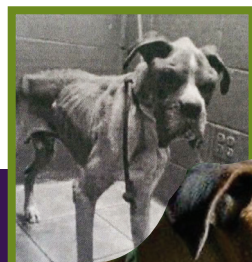
You provide a safe haven and transitional stop for a Boxer on their journey to find a loving, forever home.

To set you up for success, MLBR will provide all basic supplies (food, crates, blankets and collars) and pay for medical expenses.

We also have a **dedicated team of coordinators and trainers whose responsibility it is to make the experience safe and positive for you and your foster dog.**

How to Apply

Once submitted, our foster coordinator will contact you to answer any questions you may have and set up a home check if you would like to proceed. **We want to get to know you so we can place an incoming dog with a home that is ideally-suited for their needs.**
